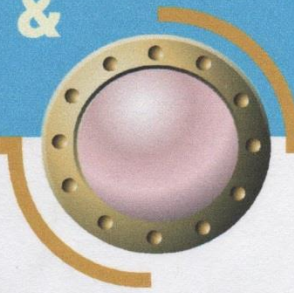


# Swindon Model Boat & Engineering Club

It is presented to the member who builds a kit model which satisfies the judges. The cup can only be awarded once for any model.



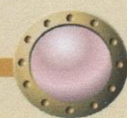
### Swindon Trophy
